Created by the Van Eyck brothers in the early 15th century, this fascinating work transports you to a world of beauty and devotion. Every meticulous detail and every stroke of oil paint speaks to the genius of the artists. Come and discover this icon of

European art, carefully restored for an unforgettable visual experience.

In the crypt of the cathedral, you will travel deep into the past with the help of an Augmented Reality device - you can choose between glasses or a tablet - and experience the eventful history of the Ghent Altarpiece as if you were there yourself. As a highlight of the tour you will have a face to face encounter with the one and only Ghent Altarpiece.
